2010 Fee Schedule

ADMISSION FEES

Application Fee: \$50 per student payable at time of lodging application forms.

Enrolment Guarantee: \$200 payable by the date nominated in the formal letter of offer (non refundable). If the fee is not received by the due date the enrolment may be cancelled.

No student may commence until all initial charges (application fee, enrolment guarantee and one term's fees) have been paid. Term 1 fees for incoming students are due by 31 October in the year prior to entry.

Tuition Fees: As well as general tuition, this covers all incidental costs including local excursions, swimming fees, diary and most subject materials. It does not cover subject excursions, camps, music tuition, text books, stationery and uniforms.

Capital Levy: A compulsory annual charge of \$500 per student billed quarterly. It is specifically used to fund the schools continuing building program. Any amounts donated in excess of this levy will be tax deductible and are gratefully received by the school.

Sibling Discounts: Discounts are given for subsequent children in the family for the period in which more than one child is enrolled at the School at the same time: 2nd child – 15%, 3rd and subsequent children – 25%. Discounts apply to **tuition fees only**.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Early Payment Discount: If payment of the full Annual Total (which includes the Capital Levy) is received by October 31, a 5% discount is applied to **tuition fees only**. If the option to pay the tuition fee in full by October 31 is not taken up, fees can be paid in quarterly instalments with due dates as set out below:

If an account becomes overdue the School's Policy for Unpaid Fees will apply, however on application, the School will consider individual circumstances and may assist in arranging a suitable payment plan.

Payment options: Payments can be made by cheque, cash, direct debit or EFTPOS

WITHDRAWAL OF A STUDENT

One full term's notice in writing is required in the case of a student choosing to withdraw from the School. Where less than one full term's notice is given in writing, one term's tuition fees will be payable.
