- Prerequisite: A study score of at least 25 in English (any other than EAL) and a study score of at least 20 in two of Biology, Chemistry, Health And Human Development, any Mathematics, Physical Education, Physics or Psychology. Can apply for and undertake the first year of the course at a regional campus such as Wodonga.
