

## YEAR 12 CAREER INFORMATION - TERTIARY APPLICATION

The following information is provided to assist students (and their parents) plan their tertiary applications. It supplements the VTAC Information Night (Wednesday 25 July, 2018).

Central offices in each state administer the application and offer process for tertiary courses in Australia.

For **Victorian** universities the central office is the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC). See [www.vtac.edu.au/](http://www.vtac.edu.au/) and get the VTAC app from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#).

VTAC will process your application for Victorian tertiary institutions but if you wish to apply for courses in another state you will need to contact the tertiary admissions centre in the same state as the institution. The courses and application instructions are listed in the appropriate interstate tertiary course guide (available in print and/or online). See below for details of admission centres/authorities for each state:

NB. A small number of institutions do not use a central office, but manage their own entry process. For these, students will need to make direct application to the institution.

### Application Process

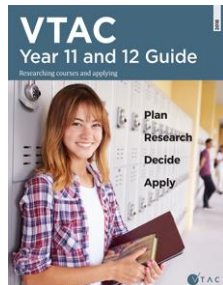
Students need to register with **each** admissions centre before they can apply for tertiary courses in that state.

To register with VTAC -

- Students will need their NESA HSC number and select a PIN to register.
- A VTAC ID number will be given after registration
- The processing fee can be paid at a later date, but must be paid by the 31 October, otherwise application will not be considered.
