Chancellor's Scholars will be guaranteed a Commonwealth Supported Place in the Doctor of Medicine providing they meet the following entry requirements:

- Successfully complete the Multi Mini Interview
- Pass all prerequisite subjects on the first attempt in the undergraduate degree.

Students who achieve an ATAR of 99+ and study a University of Melbourne Bachelor degree immediately after Year 12 will be guaranteed a full-fee paying place in the Doctor of Medicine providing they meet the following entry requirements:

- Pass all prerequisite subjects on the first attempt in the undergraduate degree
- Maintain a weighted average mark (WAM) of 75% in their undergraduate degree.

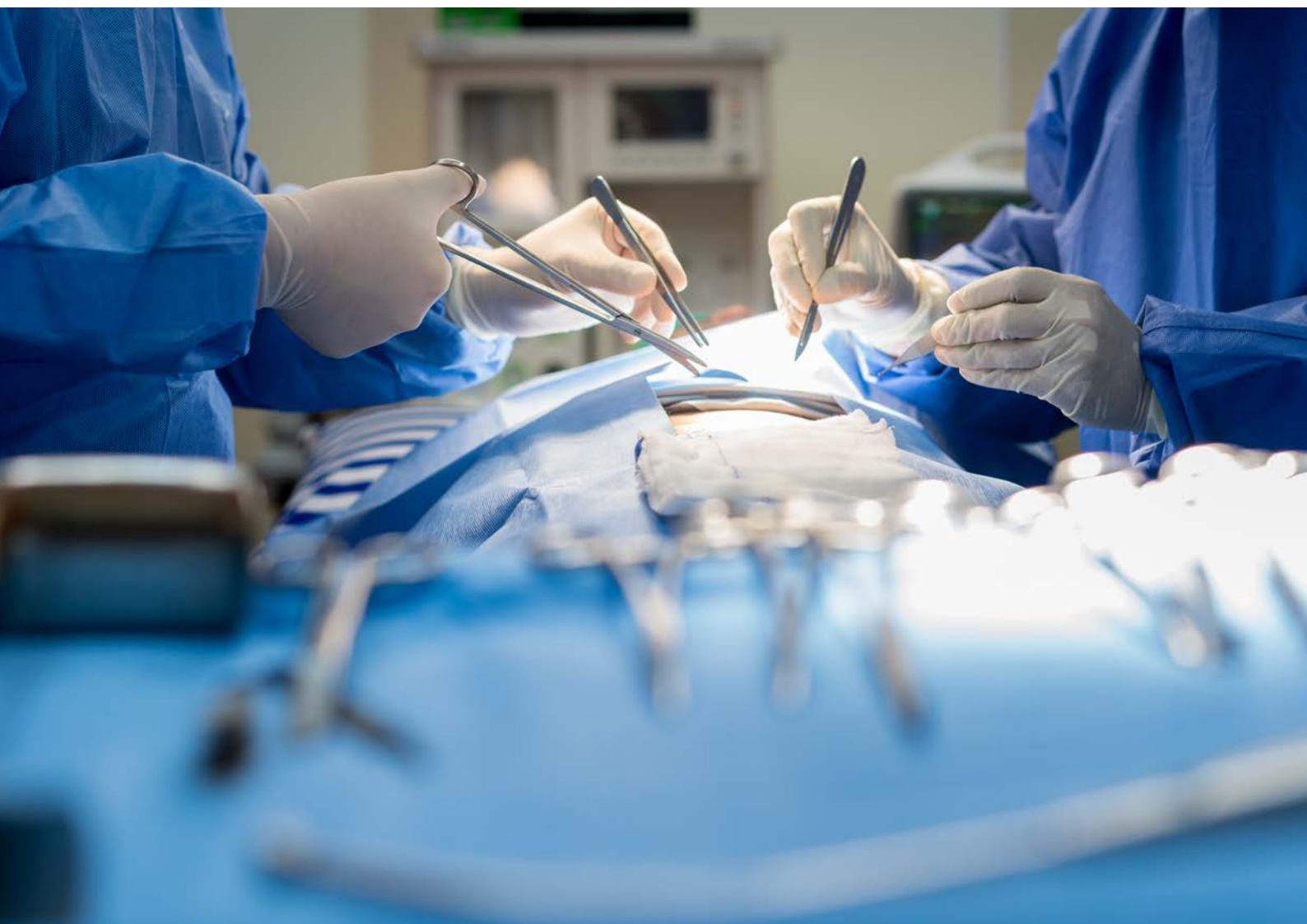
