I'M IN YEAR 12 ... HELP! ... WHAT DO I DO NOW? ...

... The good news is that you don't need to panic!

The following information has been confirmed:

- Students will complete Major Projects and sit the HSC Exams.
- HSC results will be released in mid December as originally planned.
- Students who are eligible for an ATAR will receive an ATAR this year.
- The ATAR can still be used for entry into tertiary courses for study in 2021.
- Alternate pathways are still available for entry into tertiary courses (and these may be expanded for current Year 12 students).

Please see the Term 2 Goals below. These are taken from the Key Dates document distributed at the beginning of the year to Year 12 students and families:

TERM TWO - RESEARCH/CONFIRM COURSES AND INSTITUTIONS

Goals for this term:

- Make contact with institutions to get information about specific courses you are interested in: Do you meet the prerequisites? Are there any additional requirements for entry? What was last year's ATAR? What pathway (back-up plan) options are available? Do they offer early or alternate entry schemes? Do they run experience days/information sessions/workshops? What accommodation is available? - Keep all of this in your Careers folder.
- Visit the campus and connect with institutions through social media to keep up to date with course information.

These should still be your goals for this term. The method of achieving them might need to be adjusted, so this newsletter is designed to support you in it.

The Career Newsletter this fortnight is dedicated to our Year 12 students and their families. The information may interest students of other year levels and their parents, so read on if you wish, but if you want a Career Newsletter that is more directly related to your needs, you will have to wait another fortnight.
