This fortnight's Career Newsletter has been stripped back to focus on just three items. Because, yes, they are important.

#### **Morrisby Career Assessment – attention Year 10 - 12 students (and parents)**

Students in Year 10 are completing the Morrisby Online Career Assessment today. They will be able to access their personalised online report immediately. Students in Years 11 and 12 should also login and review their online report from 2020 or 2019. Students revisiting their reports can retake elements of the assessment if their interests or aspirations have changed. This will generate a new report with updated suggestions and areas for investigation.

Students have completed a set of assessments and questionnaires, to help them discover their own unique strengths and weaknesses, preferences, and interests. These are interpreted and analysed in the context of careers and educational choices, giving suggestions for career areas, subject choices and educational pathways. Year 10 students and parents can use this information to guide HSC subject selections. Year 11 and 12 students and parents can use it to give direction or confirm post school options.

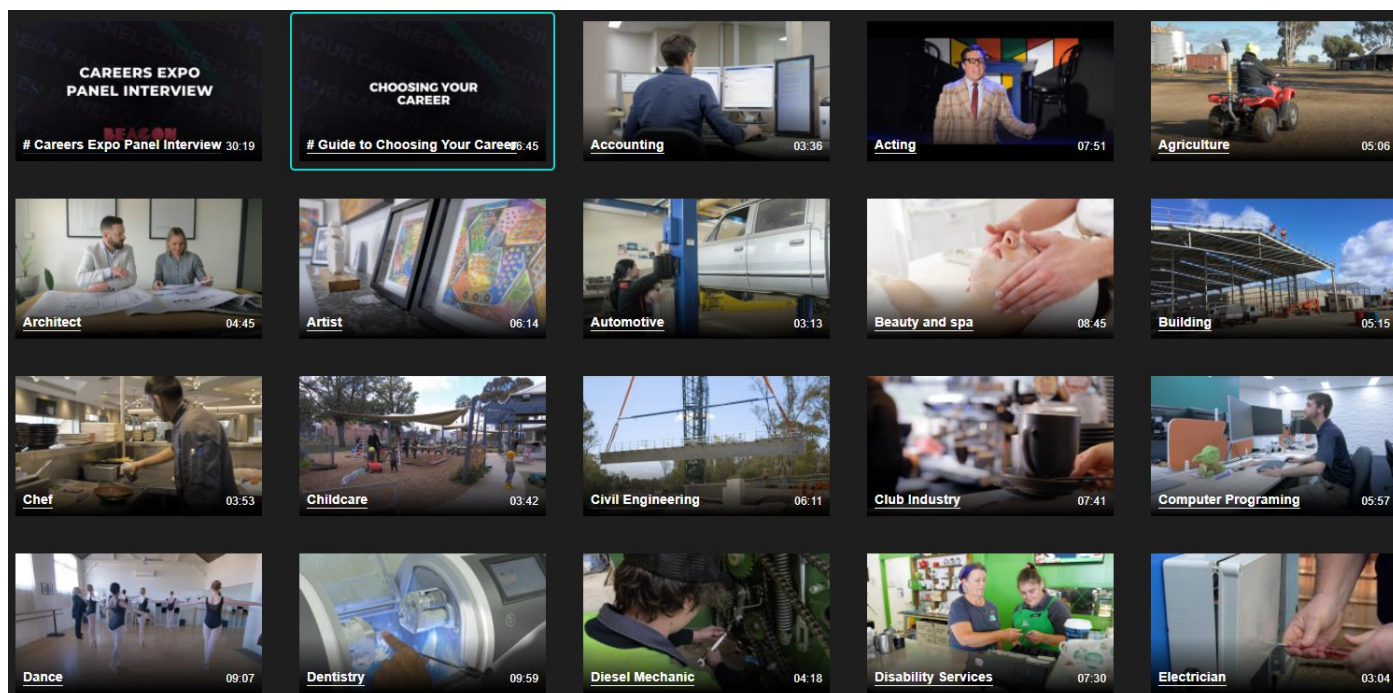
