Moama Anglican Grammar

Moama Anglican Grammar is a co-educational, independent Kindergarten - Year 12 Anglican School with an open entry policy.

Commencing in 2005 with 16 students, the School has grown rapidly to over 680 students, with facilities keeping pace with the increasing student numbers. With strong community support, sound financial management and hard work by dedicated teachers and parents, the School has developed into a thriving educational community.

In 2010 the Board made a significant strategic decision to open additional Year Levels from Kindergarten to Year 4. This expansion consolidated the School within the region as a unique single campus school offering continuous education from Kindergarten to Year 12. In addition to the building program, the academic and co-curricular programs have also been strengthened and expanded.

Offering K-12 on the one campus enables students to pass seamlessly across the traditional transition

points of primary and secondary school. Students can experience our culture of care for the duration of their schooling starting from Kindergarten, with Year 7 being the other common entry point. As a consequence, knowledge about each student can be passed on from year to year ensuring students are catered for in terms of their individual needs.

Our diverse student base resides in both NSW and Victoria. Echuca/Moama is an important agriculture region as well as having a strong tourism industry. Many families are engaged in these industries in addition to the health sector and essential services.

Students are encouraged to engage with every aspect of school life. The School operates academically as a primary school and secondary school, with various opportunities for collaboration thoughout subjects, co-curricular programs, extra-currcicular events and pastoral care programs. Students are also able to mix in the school grounds.

Applications for 2025 Academic Scholarships are open for new students, not currently attending Moama Anglican Grammar. Academic scholarships are available for entry to Years 5 - 11.

Application process:

Moama Anglican Grammar scholarship examinations are conducted by Edutest Australia.

Registration and payment for Academic Scholarship applications can only be made online.

Tuition Fee Remission and Duration:

Academic Scholarships provide for up to 75% remission of the tuition fee. All other fees are payable.

Scholarships may be awarded for two years or for the duration of secondary education, subject to the student making satisfactory progress.

Application Fee:

Applicants are required to pay a \$90 registration fee upon registering online via Edutest.

Students who have not lodged an Academic Scholarship Application are required to pay a \$90 fee with the scholarship application.

General Excellence

Available to:

Students currently attending Moama Anglican Grammar and students not yet attending the school may apply for Years 5 - 11 General Excellence Scholarships.

Tuition Fee Remission:

General Excellence Scholarships provide for up to 50% remission of the tuition fee. All other fees are payable.

Shortlist/Notification:

Applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of their written application, supported by references. Copies of latest school reports and NAPLAN testing must also be included. Evidence of the potential for

strong academic performance is required, along with a demonstrated commitment to Moama Anglican Grammar's Core Values of Compassion, Respect and Integrity.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the selection panel.

Application Fee:

Students who have lodged an application for an Academic Scholarship and paid the registration fee, will not incur a further charge for the General Excellence Scholarship application. Students who have not lodged an Academic Scholarship Application are required to pay a \$90 fee with the scholarship application.



Music/Performing Arts

Tuition Fee Remission

Available to:

Students currently attending Moama Anglican Grammar and students not yet attending the school may apply for Years 5 – 11 Music / Performing Arts Scholarships.

Tuition Fee Remission and Duration:

Music / Performing Arts Scholarships provide for up to 50% remission of the tuition fee. All other fees are payable.

Scholarships may be awarded for two years or for the duration of secondary education, subject to the student making satisfactory progress.

Shortlist/Notification:

Applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of their written application, supported by references. Copies of latest school reports and NAPLAN testing must also be included. Academic levels and achievements of students are considered but are not the predominant criteria for selection. Selection is based on music / performing arts aptitude and achievements, and demonstrated commitment to Moama Anglican Grammar's Core Values of Compassion, Respect and Integrity. Shortlisted applicants will then be invited to attend an interview with the selection panel.

Application Fee:

Students who have lodged an application for an Academic Scholarship with Edutest and paid the registration fee, will not incur a further charge for the Music/Music/Performing Arts Scholarship application. Students who have not lodged an Academic Scholarship Application are required to pay a \$90 fee with the scholarship application.



Application Process

Academic Scholarship

Our Academic scholarship exam is conducted at the School by Edutest Australia, an educational assessment organisation that provide quality assessments and services that are valid, reliable and provide meaningful feedback.

Supporting Documentation:

A recent passport style photograph Copies of latest school reports NAPLAN test results supported by references

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the selection panel.

Fees:

Students who have lodged an application for an Academic Scholarship with Edutest and paid the registration fee (\$90), will not incur a further charge for other Scholarship applications. Students who have not lodged an Academic Scholarship Application will be charged a \$90 fee with the scholarship application. Payment details can be found on the application form.
